Membership Categories

Any individual, partnership, corporation or association eligible for membership in more than one category must become a member of the association in the category that is the primary business of the member or in the higher dues paying category.

Retailers **\$375 a year** **\$31.25 a month**

Any company engaged in the sale to consumers of hearth, patio or barbecue related products.

Distributors **\$900 a year** **\$75.00 a month**

Companies engaged in the wholesale distribution to dealers, builders or other channels of distribution of hearth, patio or barbecue related products.

Associate Retailers **\$187.50 a year** **\$15.60 a month**

Any retailer wishing to add a multiple store location as a member may do so at this reduced membership rate. This location will be listed in the Member Directories & receive all correspondence from both MAHPBA & HPBA; however, this location will not receive additional badges to EXPO.

Installing Distributors **\$515 a year** **\$42.92 a month**

Companies that buy hearth, patio and barbecue products directly from manufacturers, then sell, install and service those products for residential and commercial builders.

Manufacturers' Reps **\$350 a year** **\$25.00 a month**

Companies or individuals engaged in providing independent sales representation for manufacturers of hearth, patio or barbecue related products.

Service **\$375 a year** **\$31.25 a month**

Chimney sweeps, installers, and companies engaged in providing mechanical services relating to hearth, patio or barbecue related products.

Non-Profit **\$175 a year** **\$14.60 a month**

Organizations having a non-profit, non-commercial interest in hearth, patio or barbecue related products.

Non-Resident **\$100 a year** **\$8.34 a month**

Companies or individuals having a commercial interest in the hearth, patio or barbecue products industries already holding current membership in another HPBA affiliate.

Associates **\$865 a year** **\$72.10 a month**

Companies having a commercial interest in the hearth, patio or barbecue products industries, including – but not limited to – gas utilities, publications, testing, laboratories, insurers, insurance agencies, financial institutions, business systems providers, advertising agencies, public relations firms, etc.
